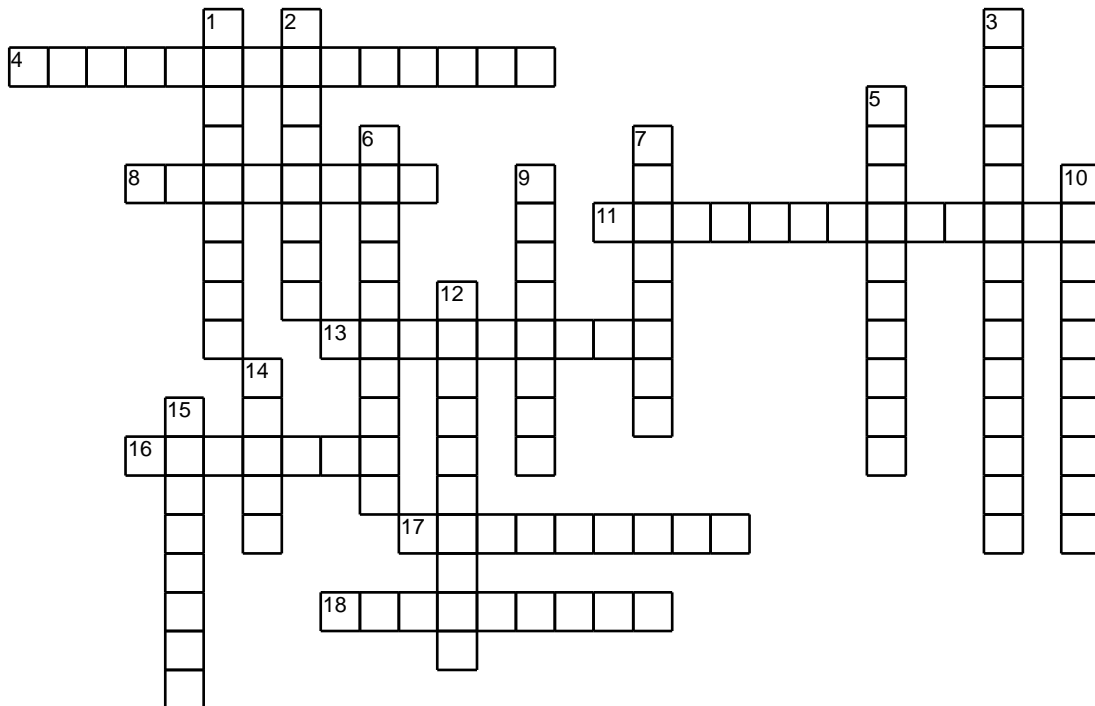


Bacteria
